## **Georgia Office of Lt. Governor Statutory Duties**

## **Summary**

The Georgia lieutenant governor has two (2) statutory duties. These cover gubernatorial succession.

## **Citations**

Statutory duties of the Lieutenant Governor as prescribed by the Official Code of Georgia Annotated (OCGA):

- 1. Shall exercise the powers and duties of the Governor when temporarily disabled until such time as the temporary disability of the Governor ends. (OCGA 45-5A-2)
- 2. Acts as gubernatorial successor. (OCGA 45-12-7)

The Georgia **Constitution** states that the Lieutenant Governor:

- 1. Shall be President of the Senate. (Article 5, Section 1, Para 3)
- 2. Shall have executive duties as prescribed by the governor. (Article 5, Section 1, Para 3)
- 3. Shall have such powers as prescribed by law/statute. (Article 5, Section 1, Para 3)
