Kentucky is a state with its own code, KRS 11.400, devoted to listing duties of the lieutenant governor. Statutory duties of the Lieutenant Governor as prescribed by Kentucky Revised Statutes (KRS):

- Serves as a member of the Governor's Executive Cabinet (KRS 11.065).
- 2. Serves as vice chairman of the State Property and Buildings Commission (KRS 56.450).
- 3. Serves as vice chairman of the Kentucky Turnpike Authority (KRS 175.430).
- 4. Serves as a member of the Kentucky Council on Agriculture (KRS 247.417).
- Appoints one (1) member of the Public Officials' Compensation Commission (KRS 64.742).
- 6. Serves as a member of the Board of the Kentucky Housing Corporation (KRS 198A.030).
- 7. Serves as a member of Kentucky delegations on the following interstate compact commissions or boards:
 - a. The Southern Growth Policies Board (KRS 147.585),
 - b. The Breaks Interstate Park Commission (KRS 148.225),
 - c. The Falls of the Ohio Interstate Park Commission (KRS 148.242),
 - d. The Tennessee-Tombigbee Waterway Development Authority (KRS 182.305),
 - e. The Interstate Water Sanitation Control Commissions (KRS 224.18-710; and
- f. The Kentucky Mining Advisory Council for the Interstate Mining Compact (KRS 350.310.
