2 **ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP AWARD**

3 WHEREAS, the members of the National Lieutenant Governors Association (NLGA) recognize
4 many members play key roles in issues regarding energy and environmental stewardship in the
5 United States and its territories; and

6 WHEREAS, energy and environmental stewardship efforts may enhance the lives of all
7 Americans and impact every aspect of life in America today including energy, the economy,
8 community and building design, agriculture, water and other resources, clean technology, the
9 environment, transportation, social problem solving, job creation, education, health and health
10 care, and more; and

11 WHEREAS, public officials every day face the challenge and responsibility of balancing
12 development to meet today's needs with the ability of future generations to meet their needs;
