



**SETS A SUNSET CLAUSE OF THREE YEARS  
ON ALL NLGA POLICY RESOLUTIONS**

**WHEREAS**, a sunset clause is a provision providing that a resolution will expire on a particular date, unless it is reauthorized by the membership, and

**WHEREAS**, without a sunset clause a resolution of the National Lieutenant Governors Association (NLGA) continues indefinitely as a binding statement of the NLGA, and

**WHEREAS**, the NLGA membership changes over time, and

**WHEREAS**, the nature and circumstances surrounding an issue at a given time may change profoundly with the passage of time,

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, as NLGA began in 2009, NLGA continues to place a sunset clause of three years on all NLGA policy resolutions, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, expiration occurs three years from the time of passage at the next regularly scheduled meeting during which resolutions can be passed, and

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, the staff of NLGA shall make NLGA members aware of resolutions, by title, which will expire at the next regularly scheduled meeting, and
