1 **Resolution Continuing The Public Leadership**
2 **In Healthy Lifestyles Award**

3 WHEREAS, the members of the National Lieutenant Governors Association (NLGA)
4 recognize many members play key roles in issues regarding public health in the United
5 States and its territories; and

6 WHEREAS, advancing healthy lifestyles contributes to the health and wellness of the lives of
7 Americans and may impact multiple aspects of life in America including health care costs,
8 wellness, work and school productivity, public health, health innovation, health knowledge,
9 community activity and design, social problem solving, and more; and

10 WHEREAS, health care innovation impacts the bottom line of state, territories, entities, and
11 individuals; and

12 WHEREAS, Takeda Pharmaceuticals USA notes the global economy requires corporations
13 to create relationships participating in the communities in which they operate; and

14 WHEREAS, Takeda Pharmaceuticals USA is long-time partner of the NLGA through its

25 session at that meeting if additional awards partnerships are put in place in the future.
