## <u>NLGA Consensus Resolution On The Importance of Beautification and Anti-</u> <u>Littering Efforts in the States and Territories</u>

- WHEREAS, the National Lieutenant Governors Association has an opportunity to highlight the important issue of litter, and to examine the different state strategies that impact public policy and budgets, and
- 6 WHEREAS, states and territories promote tourism, economic development, natural beauty,
- 7 beautiful architecture, and historic communities, but litter is a blight on cities, counties, parks,
- 8 roadways, and waterways, and
- 9 WHEREAS, according to the most recent National Litter Study (2020) by Keep America
- Beautiful, there is an estimated 50 billion pieces of litter on the ground in America, with 152 items of litter per person in the U.S.,<sup>1</sup> and
- 12 WHEREAS, litter, misplaced trash, and debris are detrimental to a state/territory's image and
- negatively impact economic development, community investment, infrastructure, and tourism,and
- 15 WHEREAS, improperly placed materials along roadways and in waterways negatively affects
- 16 an individual's place and connection to their neighborhoods and communities, and have
- 17 adverse effects on the quality of life for humans and wildlife, and
- 18 WHEREAS, litter's indirect negative economic impacts include lost tourism revenues,
- expenses for repairing vehicles, boats and ships, restoration of ecosystems, wildlife injury,
  environmental contamination, and eventually the cost to human health, and
- WHEREAS, state government leaders can positively impact the beautification of communities by supporting efforts to reduce litter such as: promote anti-littering campaigns, organize litter pickup events, educate youth and citizens on the impact of litter, work collaboratively with
- 24 businesses to identify litter reduction opportunities, and support local organizations working
- 25 to reduce litter and beautify communities.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the National Lieutenant Governors Association
- 27 (NLGA) recognizes the importance of promoting awareness of litter as a community nuisance,
- 28 and supports efforts in the states and territories to discourage and prevent littering and other
- 29 harmful behaviors to local environments.
- 30 **ADOPTED**, this day, the 10<sup>th</sup> of April, 2025.
