NLGA Consensus Resolution on the Importance of Awareness and Education on Type 1 Diabetes

- 3 WHEREAS, type 1 diabetes is an autoimmune chronic medical condition affecting millions of
- 4 individuals worldwide, and
- 5 WHEREAS, a type 1 diabetes diagnosis obligates a child or adult diagnosed with the condition to
- take insulin, utilize a variety of technologies, and see a variety of doctors throughout a patient's
- 7 lifetime at a measurable cost to manage the disease, and
- 8 WHEREAS, type 1 diabetes is now recognized as developing over three stages (e.g., stage 1, stage
- 9 2, and stage 3) with a diagnosis of each stage potentially allowing for early interventions to alter
- 10 the course of this autoimmune disease, and
- 11 **WHEREAS**, screening tools may help identify the onset and diagnosis of type 1 diabetes,
- especially for those with a close living relative living with type 1 diabetes, helping patients to avoid
- or forestall a condition known as diabetes ketoacidosis (DKA), and
- 14 WHEREAS, the dedicated efforts of healthcare professionals, advocacy groups, and individuals
- living with type 1 diabetes play a significant role in addressing this global health concern, and
- 16 WHEREAS, additional efforts to promote awareness of type 1 diabetes, including the risk factors
- associated with developing the condition, may help the patients at risk or living with the condition.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the National Lieutenant Governors Association
- 19 (NLGA) recognizes the importance of educating the public about the signs of type 1 diabetes and
- 20 the steps families can take to identify the risks of the condition present in a person each day.
- 21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that NLGA encourages the public to take proactive and early steps in
- learning how to identify, forestall, and manage type 1 diabetes through regular check-ups and
- 23 education.
- 24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that NLGA and its Members recognize the strength and resilience of
- 25 the individuals and families affected by type 1 diabetes.
