1 Resolution Continuing The NLGA Improving Lives and Communities Award

- 2 WHEREAS, the members of the National Lieutenant Governors Association (NLGA) recognize many members
- 3 play key roles in issues regarding healthcare and public health in the United States and its territories, and
- 4 WHEREAS, healthcare policy at the state level impacts the health and wellness of the lives of Americans, as well as
- 5 health care costs, wellness, work and school productivity, public health, health innovation, health knowledge,
- 6 community activity and design, social problem solving, and more, and
- WHEREAS, health care innovation impacts the bottom line of state, territories, entities, and individuals, and
- 8 WHEREAS, Anthem understands that health connects all communities and recognizes the importance of innovation
- 9 and effectiveness in healthcare policy, and
- 10 WHEREAS, Anthem is long-time partner of the NLGA through its public-private sector program, and has
- 11 committed to support and present an award to members for a minimum of three years as an NLGA Chairman Level
- 12 Partner, and
- 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the National Lieutenant Governors Association authorizes its
- 14 Director, under the direction annually of the Chair, to work with Anthem to present the NLGA Improving Lives and
- 15 Communities Award to an NLGA member recognizing their action advancing healthcare and health policy,
- 16 understanding that same will create no negative fiscal impact to NLGA.
- 17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Improving Lives and Communities Award will be presented annually to
- 18 an NLGA member at the spring meeting of the NLGA, possibly as part of an meeting session or evening event as
- 19 determined by NLGA.
