1	Resolution in Support of Efficiency and Innovation in Government Procurement
2	with Cooperative Purchasing
3 4	<b>WHEREAS,</b> government procurement and cooperative purchasing play a significant role in the quality and efficiency of business and government throughout the United States, and
5 6 7 8	WHEREAS, state purchasing operations have direct responsibility for purchasing goods, services, and construction; executing and implementing contracts; creating forecasts and procurement strategies; and developing working relationships with suppliers and state and local government agencies, and
9 10	<b>WHEREAS,</b> state and local governments spend over \$4 trillion annually <sup>i</sup> , which directly impacts local, state, national, and international economies, and
11 12 13	WHEREAS, cooperative purchasing is procurement conducted on behalf of all public entities for the purchase of products and services available for use by other state and local governments through cooperative purchasing statutes and joint exercise of powers statutes, and
14 15	<b>WHEREAS,</b> state and local governments are estimated to have spent \$275 billion by 2026 through cooperative purchasing contracts <sup>ii</sup> , and
16 17 18 19 20	WHEREAS, cooperative purchasing is a competitive, transparent, and public solicitation and contract award process that may offer myriad benefits for state and local governments, including time administrative efficiencies, national volume pricing, cost efficiencies generated from economies of scale, accelerated access to the supply chain, and access to leading industry vendors and suppliers <sup>iii</sup> , and
21 22 23 24	WHEREAS, cooperative purchasing is rooted in an open and fair competitive process that ensures maximum competition among industry vendors and suppliers to the benefit of government and allows vendors and suppliers to maximize their resources by utilizing a single government contract, and

WHEREAS, cooperative purchasing contracts meet or exceed government procurement standards,

WHEREAS, cooperative purchasing is a trusted, efficient, and innovative procurement tool used

across North America to enhance government procurement and is recognized as a best practice by

- 29 the American Bar Association<sup>iv</sup>, the National Institute of Government Procurement<sup>v</sup>, the National
- 30 Association of State Procurement Officials<sup>vi</sup>, and the National Purchasing Institute<sup>vii</sup>.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the National Lieutenant Governors Association expresses
- 32 support for cooperative purchasing and procurement strategies that may increase cost savings to
- 33 government, improve the procurement process at the state and local level, and result in improved
- 34 efficiencies in state and local government.
- 35 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that NLGA encourages its Members in the states and territories to
- 36 explore the ways cooperative purchasing promotes efficiency and innovation in procurement, and
- 37 ensures the efficient stewardship of taxpayer dollars.
