1 **NLGA Consensus Resolution Establishing the NLGA Economic Engine Award**
2 WHEREAS, the National Lieutenant Governors Association (NLGA) has the mission to improve the
3 efficiency and effectiveness of state and territorial government through interstate cooperation and
4 the exchange of ideas and innovations, and

5 WHEREAS, NLGA Members, as the nation's lieutenant governors and seconds-in-command in the
6 states and territories, oversee and implement initiatives that promote economic growth and
7 workforce development, that may contribute to the overall well-being and prosperity of the state or
8 territory they serve, and

9 WHEREAS, the National Association of Home Builders (NAHB) is an organization that strives to
10 protect housing opportunities for all, while working to achieve professional success for its members
11 who build communities, create jobs, and strengthen the economy, and

12 WHEREAS, NAHB is long-time partner of the NLGA through its public-private sector program, and
13 has committed to support and present an award to Members for a minimum of three years as an
14 NLGA Partner, and

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the National Lieutenant Governors Association
16 authorizes its Executive Director, under the direction annually of the Chair, to work with the
17 National Association of Home Builders (NAHB) to present an NLGA Economic Engine Award to an
18 NLGA Member recognizing their contributions to driving growth and prosperity through economic
19 and workforce opportunities in state and territorial government, understanding that it will create no
20 negative fiscal impact to NLGA.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award will first be presented at the 2026 Spring Business
22 Meeting in April 2026 and continued thereafter at an NLGA Meeting in the Spring, pending
23 continued agreement between NLGA and NAHB.
