“Grades are a good indicator of how a student is doing, but if you just look at grades, you miss a lot of things: friends-group changes, attendance, health, all of a sudden a student is getting too skinny. Building Assets, Reducing Risks (BARR) is an evidence based strengths-based K-12 coaching and training partner that raises student math and reading scores, decreases chronic absenteeism, increases teacher satisfaction and retention, and decreases student disciplinary incidents and suspensions.

Most Researched Model in the Nation

20 statistically significant outcomes

78 schools involved in randomized controlled trial research (most rigorous possible)

Student Impacts:

- Increase in Math achievement scores
- Increase in English achievement scores
- More credits earned
- More courses passed
- Higher GPA
- Reduced chronic absenteeism
- Greater rigor and expectations
- More supportive relationships
- Increased engagement
- Stronger impacts on students in poverty
- Stronger impacts on struggling students

Teacher Impacts:

- Increase in self-efficacy
- View of school support
- Use of data
- Collaboration with colleagues
- View of students' observed behavior
- Perception of students' behavior



BARR reduces the failure rate by an average of 35%


Johnson Central High School, who began BARR as a Validation study school and was the first BARR school in the state, is now ranked

School	First year	By 2024-25:
Johnson Central High School	2015-16	reduced their 9th grade failure rate from 18% to 2%
Woodford County High School	2022-23	Saw a 19% reduction in 9th grade chronic absenteeism
Pike County Central High School	2022-23	Saw a 37% reduction in 9th grade failure rate
