The Dignity Index, developed in 2021, is an eight-point scale for measuring how we talk to each other when we disagree. Using a few core beliefs: 1) Contempt causes division; dignity eases division; 2) If we put a spotlight on dignity and contempt, we will use more dignity and less contempt; and 3) If we show Americans how they can help ease our divisions, they will jump on it; the Dignity Index can help ease divisions, prevent violence, and solve problems.
