### **Thirty of the State's Seconds-in-Command Commit to Advance NLGA Policy Work**

Thirty of the nation's second-highest ranking state and territorial officials are committed to actively advance the collaborative work of the National Lieutenant Governors Association (NLGA).

"Thirty lieutenant governors are serving on NLGA operational and leadership committees," said NLGA Director Julia Hurst.

NLGA Chair Oklahoma Lt. Governor Todd Lamb appointed seven working committees to complement the activity of the NLGA Executive Committee. Lt. Governor Lamb tapped lieutenant governors to serve in pivotal policy areas, as follows:
